DISASTER RELIEF

When a disaster happens God's people respond in many ways; first with prayer, but then giving of a variety of gifts and abilities to help those touched by that disaster. The folks in Texas are now beginning a long road to recovery in the wake of Hurricane Harvey. To partner with those giving toward this relief effort, **Lutheran Foundation of St. Louis** has created a special one-time matching fund of up to \$400,000 to increase the impact of support given. Of this, any gifts given through Immanuel-Olivette will be matched up to \$10,000. HURRICANE HARVEY DISASTER RESPONSE
